- This book-length project studies the nexus of human security and state-society relations in international border politics, with a focus on local communities. I take up the challenge of theorizing borderlands as unique geopolitical spaces and local communities as central actors. The theory explains local resistance against hardening, how hardening drives social differentiation, and the influence of bottom-up demands on hardening. The multi-method design encompasses quantitative analyses with original geospatial data, qualitative fieldwork at the United States—Mexico border, and both observational and experimental survey tests.
